The present application has been filed by the petitioner-wife under Section 24 of C.P.C. for transfer of case No. HMA-94 of 2018, titled as Raju Ranga Vs. Anchal, filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, pending in the Court of Additional District Judge, Panchkula to any competent Court of jurisdiction at District Courts, Panipat.

Admittedly, the petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. is pending in District Panipat as well as proceedings in pursuance to the FIR registered against the respondent is also pending in District Panipat. The divorce petition has been filed by the respondent-husband at District Courts, Panchkula. It is stated that she has no source of income to maintain herself and to pursue her case by traveling from Samalkha, District Panipat to Panchkula on each and every date of hearing and therefore, she is not able to defend the case in a proper manner.

Taking into account the above facts as also the kind of averments as alleged, this Court deems it proper to transfer the case bearing No. HMA-94 of 2018, titled as Raju Ranga Vs. Anchal, filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act from Panchkula to the competent Court of jurisdiction at District Courts, Panipat. The record be sent to competent Court of jurisdiction at District Courts, Panipat.

The present application stands allowed in the above terms.
