This transfer application has been filed by Wife-Sapna Rani for transfer of petition under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act pending in the Court of learned Additional Civil Judge (Sr.Divn.), Ferozepur to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Mansa.

However, today the appellant and respondent i.e. wife and husband have appeared before us and it is urged by learned counsel for the appellant that the matter has been compromised between them and as such, wife-Sapna Rani does not want to pursue her transfer application.
