Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.229 dated 21.08.2019 under Sections 147, 148, 149, 294, 323, 341, 506 IPC, Sections 25/27 of Arms Act (Act No.54) and Section 3(1)(r)(s) of SC&ST Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Hansi, District Hisar.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 05.11.2019: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order dated 31.10.2019 passed in CRM-M-44954-2019, vide which co-accused Subham Duhan has been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by this Court. It is further submitted that neither any specific role has been attributed to the petitioner nor a word has been

attributed to him regarding caste of the complainant...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dholu Ram, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 05.11.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
