The petitioner is aggrieved by the alleged inaction on the part of the police authorities of the State of Punjab upon his complaint dated 27.9.2017. This complaint was made by the petitioner in relation to the alleged misuse of the votes of one Raghubir Chand Singal and one Feroz Khan during the E-voting in relation to an Extraordinary General Body Meeting of M/s Supreme Tex Mart Limited, convened upon the requisition of the petitioner and another. It is however an admitted fact that the said Raghubir Chand Singal, whose vote was allegedly misused during the process of the E-voting, has already approached the National Company Law Tribunal, Chandigarh, in relation thereto and the said Forum is seized of the issue.

That being so, the petitioner has no personal cause to canvass before the police authorities, whereby he can now complain of inaction upon his complaint. The writ petition is utterly misconceived and is accordingly dismissed.
