The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.94 dated 16.08.2019, under Sections 370(iv), 365, 420, 120-B and 34 of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Division No.1 Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein it is mentioned that two motorcyclists had kidnapped the son of the complainant. The child was recovered unharmed and handed over to his parents. He also contends that the complainant had earlier agreed to give the child in adoption to co-accused Inderjit Kaur for a consideration and later on due to monetary dispute the complainant had filed the FIR. He also contends that the co-accused namely Rajwinder Kaur and Tilak Raj had been granted anticipatory bail by this Court in CRM-M-39791-2019 on

17.10.2019. The petitioner is not involved in any other case.

This Court, by the order dated 16.11.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Devi Dayal, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 16.11.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
