Mr. J.S. Dahiya, Advocate has appeared on behalf of the respondent by filing vakalatnama. He states that the matter has been compromised between the parties in terms of which the parties have decided to get their marriage dissolved by decree of divorce by way of mutual consent and have filed a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act in that regard, where statements of both the spouses have been recorded and a sum of Rs.5 lacs has been paid by the husband to the wife, out of the total settled amount of Rs.10 lacs and now the case is pending for 03.08.2019 for recording of statements of the petitioners on second motion. Learned counsel states that the respondent would withdraw the divorce petition in question since both the petitions cannot proceed together.

Hearing such statement of learned counsel for the

respondent, learned counsel for the applicant states that he be permitted to withdraw the present application. Allowed.
