Application is allowed. Written statement alongwith annexures on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2 are taken on record.

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The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 05.05.2017, vide which, direction was issued to the respondents to release the salary for the period of three months i.e. from 09.05.2015 to 09.08.2015.

Learned counsel for the respondents has however handed over copy of order dated 27.03.2018 passed in the same writ petition wherein it has been observed that:-

“As far as the salary of the said period is concerned, it be not paid because non-joining has not sufficiently been explained except against the repatriation order, the present petition has been filed after two months of the relieving by the BBMB. However, the period be not treated adverse against the petitioner for service benefits.”

In view of the same, the present contempt petition is dismissed.
Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
