The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.67 dated 14.05.2019, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Phase-11, District SAS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is an outcome of a quarrel which took place between the petitioner and the complainant as the complainant had brought a girl to his room. He further contends that no specific injury has been attributed to the petitioner and the injured has fully recovered from the injuries. He also contends that the girl has also registered an FIR under Section 376 IPC against the complainant. The petitioner is in custody for over six months and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Jatinder Kumar, states that 04 out of 16 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over six months, he is not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take sometime, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
