On 19.5.2018 this Court had passed the following order :-

“As per office report, notices could not be issued to the respondents as counsel for the appellant has not furnished the process fee.

Fresh notices to the respondents be issued for 16.10.2018 through ordinary process, registered post and dasti as well, on furnishing requisite copies of paper book, registered cover and incidental expenses, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

It is clarified that non-compliance of this order in its letter and spirit, would entail dismissal of this appeal for want of prosecution.”

As per office report, notices could not be issued to the respondents as learned counsel for the appellant did not file process fee, registered covers and copies of the paper book.

In view of the above and in terms of the afore-quoted order, as also for the reason that for the three consecutive dates, none has appeared on behalf of the appellant, the present appeal is dismissed for non-prosecution.
