In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the petitioner is that though he has already retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation on 30.06.2018 but all the benefits for which he is entitled after his retirement, have not been extended to him without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is no impediment in the release of the pensionary benefits of the petitioner as there are no proceedings pending against the petitioner either departmental or before any competent Court of law, which would entitle the respondents to withhold the pensionary benefits of the petitioner.

The prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to release the pensionary benefits of the petitioner forthwith.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 23.07.2019 (Annexure P-3) to the respondents, which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is

issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 23.07.2019 (Annexure P-3), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 23.07.2019 (Annexure P-3), within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits after the decision of the representation, the same should also be paid to him within three months thereafter.
