Pursuant to the order dated 05.11.2019, the petitioner has joined investigation, with learned State counsel submitting that he has got recovered the .12 bore gun, as is alleged to have been used in the commission of the crime (with it to be noticed that it is not a case of injury) and consequently, his custodial

interrogation is not required.

That being so, without commenting on the actual merits of the case, the petition is disposed of, with the order dated 05.11.2019 made absolute on the same terms and conditions.

However, the aforesaid order will not be treated to be an observation of this court on the merits of the case, but only in view of the fact that the investigating agency itself has stated that it does not require custodial interrogation of the petitioner.

Naturally, the complainant would be at liberty to avail of his remedy as available to him as regards any grievance, including the investigation process.

CRM-M-49085 of 2019

In this case, learned State counsel submits that though the petitioner has joined investigation, he is not getting the pistol/revolver stated to have been used in the alleged commission of the crime recovered (with it to be noticed again that there was no injury sustained by anybody).

Learned State counsel would determine as to whether any person in the family of the petitioner has been issued a licence to possess a pistol/revolver.

Adjourned to 30.01.2020.

Interim order to continue till the next date of hearing.
