FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner Gourav Sheoran, who was initially named as a co-accused of principal accused Majid, has sought this anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.227 dated 02.04.2017 under Sections 109, 115, 120-B, 323, 376, 450, 506, 34 IPC pertaining to Police Station DLF, District Gurugram, wherein he has been summoned as an additional accused with the aid of Section 319 Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner Mr. R.S. Rai, Senior Advocate assisted by Mr. Karan Pathak, Advocate inter alia contends that there is no specific role attributed to the petitioner in commission of the offence and that he has no connection with the principal accused Majid.

On behalf of the State, Ms. Mahima Yashpal, Asstt. Advocate General, Haryana on instructions from ASI (Ms.) Munesh

Kumari, fairly concedes at the bar that no specific role is attributed to the petitioner in commission of the offence and that the principal accused Majid is the person responsible for commission of the offence.

Be that as it may, going through the submissions of the two sides and the fact that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner, this Court is of the opinion that it would be a travesty of justice to send the petitioner in custody in the present case and his joining the trial would suffice the purpose. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court within a period of fifteen days from today and on his doing so, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
