Impugned herein is relieving order dated 22.10.2019 (Annexure P-9), whereby, the petitioners have been ordered to be relieved from their present place of posting with immediate effect.

2. Contents of the writ petition have been perused.

3. Transfer being matter of administrative exigencies, this Court generally interferes, if at all, very cautiously. Transfer is not a punishment but an essential aspect of service, particularly, on a transferable post.

4. In my opinion, in the present case, the impugned order dated 22.10.2019 (Annexure P-9) does not call for any interference from this Court in exercise of its extraordinary writ jurisdiction vested under Article 226 of Constitution of India.

5. Petition is, accordingly, dismissed being devoid of any merit.
