Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C') for quashing of FIR No. 3 dated 23.01.2016, under Sections 420, 406 and Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Tibber Tehsil and District Gurdaspur as well as the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

This Court on 04.12.2018 passed the following order:-

“In compliance of previous order dated 13.11.2018, Sh. Harvinder Singh, PPS, SP, Investigation, Gurdaspur is present in the Court and has filed Status Report by way of his affidavit dated 03.12.2018. The same is taken on record. Copy supplied to the opposite side. He assured this Court that the entire investigation will be completed in FIR No.03 dated 23.01.2016 within a period of three months.

Adjourned to **04.04.2019** for further consideration.”

Today learned State counsel on instructions from Raghubir

Singh, SI, has apprised this Court that after completion of investigation, both the petitioners have found to be innocent. Further stated that cancellation report has been prepared and the same will be submitted before the Court of competent jurisdiction within four weeks from today.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter.

The petition stands disposed off.

However, if the occasion so arises, the petitioners would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law.
