The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 10.3.2017, vide which, direction was issued to decide the legal notice dated 24.1.2017 of the petitioner and in case the petitioner is found entitled to the claim as prayed for, the payment shall be released to the petitioner.

Reply has been filed stating therein that the amount has since been released to the petitioner. However, the said reply did not mention the security amount of ₹ 23,60,000/-, which too has been released to the petitioner on 14.3.2019.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed. Consequently, the application for impleadment is also dismissed.
