The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.775 dated 01.09.2019 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 326 & 506 IPC, at Police Station City Karnal, District Karnal.

It is contended by counsel for the petitioner that the case against the petitioner is totally concocted. Even as per the case of the prosecution, there is only solitary injury caused to the complainant on the shoulder. The petitioner is in custody since 07.10.2019. There is no other case against the petitioner. Even in this case the investigation stands completed qua the petitioner. Hence, the petitioner deserves to be released on bail pending trial.

On the other hand, counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Ravi Kumar, submits that the weapon of the offence has been duly recovered from the petitioner. He is the only person who is named to have caused grievous injury. However, it is not disputed that there is

no other case against the petitioner and that the petitioner is in custody since 07.10.2019.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
