The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.431 dated 26.07.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341 and 506 IPC (Sections 379-B and 307 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Quilla, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein four persons have been specifically named. The offence under Section 307 IPC has been added later on upon the statement of Ankur, brother of the injured, without obtaining any medical opinion. Offence under Section 379-B was also added later on as it was alleged that gold chain was snatched. The petitioner and the complainant reside in the same locality and in case the petitioner was involved, the complainant would have named him in the FIR. He is not involved in any other case.

This Court, by order dated 06.11.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Satish Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation and not required for custodial interrogation, the order dated 06.11.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
