The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of direction to the official respondent to conduct proper enquiry in the present matter and register the FIR under Section 302 IPC alongwith other relevant sections, against the accused persons.

It is the case of the petitioner that Jaswinder Singh, husband of the petitioner, has been murdered by the private persons, but the police officials have prepared a false diary No.22 dated 22.06.2016.

Vide order dated 27.07.2017, notice of motion was issued and respondent No.3 was directed to file the reply by way of affidavit.

short affidavit of Inderbir Singh, IPS, former Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, now Assistant Inspector General of Police, Policy & Rules, Punjab, has been filed.

In the said reply, it has been mentioned that the action would be taken as per the viscera report.

Learned State counsel submits that report of viscera has been received in which it is mentioned that organophosphorus compound has been detected. He further submits that no case under Section 302 IPC is made out.

In view of the above, the present petition has become infructuous.
