Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
for quashing of case FIR No.70 dated 30.04.2008, under Sections 326,
324, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police
Station Sadar Nawanshahr, District S.B.S. Nagar and all consequential
proceedings arising therefrom.

It has been pointed out by learned counsel for the
petitioner that in terms of the order dated 22.02.2019, the petitioner
has joined the proceedings before learned trial Court and he does not
wish to challenge the quashing of FIR No. 70 dated 30.04.2008, under
Sections 326, 324, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code,
registered at Police Station Sadar Nawanshahr, District S.B.S. Nagar.

In view of the above, the order dated 22.02.2019 is made

absolute and the present petition stands disposed off.

However, it is clarified that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with proceedings before learned trial Court and not to seek any unnecessary adjournments.
