The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.152 dated 20.09.2019, under Sections 308, 332, 333 and 353 IPC, registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that the driver of the vehicle, after being signaled by the police party to stop, had tried to accelerate his vehicle and caused injuries to the complainant. He also contends that the petitioner, who is 62 years of age, is in custody for over a month and is not involved in any other case. He also contends that there is a delay of two days in registering the FIR.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Paramjit, states that two injuries were caused to the complainant which included a fracture on his leg.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is 62 years of age, he is in custody for over a month, he is not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take sometime, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
