[1] Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for promotion to the post of TGT (Punjabi).

[2] Learned counsel states that the petitioner has served legal notice (Annexure P-6) dated 07.09.2019 in respect of the claim, which is the subject matter of the writ petition, but the same has not been decided, till date and in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage, by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice (Annexure P-6) dated 07.09.2019, in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

[3] Without commenting upon the merits of the claim, the writ petition is ***disposed of***, by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice (Annexure P-6) dated 07.09.2019, in accordance with law, within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
