This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of certiorari quashing the order dated 21.12.2018 (Annexure P-1 Colly) qua petitioner to the extent of date of regularization vide which services of the petitioner have been regularized w.e.f. 19.08.2014 instead of 01.04.2011 i.e. the date junior has been regularized.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Director Secondary Education, Haryana, Shiksha Sadan, Panchkula, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 16.05.2019 (Annexure P-4) expeditiously.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr. Ayuwan Singh, A.A.G., Haryana in the Court today.

Heard.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director Secondary Education, Haryana, Shiksha Sadan, Panchkula, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 16.05.2019 (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the request made by the petitioner is admissible, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the request made by the petitioner is not admissible, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
