AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed alleging disobedience of the order dated 20.11.2017 passed by this Court in CWP No. 26329 of 2017. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners but without expressing any views on the merits of the allegations moreso when we have not heard the Sarpanch and other respondents at this stage, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the D.D.P.O., Jalandhar and the B.D.P.O., Phillaur to look into the allegations made by the petitioners and take the remedial action as may be required in law and in accordance with principles of natural justice. The needful shall be done within a period of three months from the date of receiving a

certified copy of this order.”

Reply by way of affidavit of Ajay Kumar, D.D.P.O., Jalandhar has been filed. The order dated 28.1.2019 has been annexed with the reply.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the order passed by this Court has been complied with as the grievance raised by the petitioners in the representation has been redressed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the grievance has not been properly appreciated by the respondents.

The contention raised by learned counsel for the petitioners does not fall within the ambit of present contempt. The direction of this court was to look into the allegations and take remedial measures, if so required.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that she may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail remedies against the order passed by the respondents.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
