The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 18.07.2018 vide which a direction was issued to the respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner and to conduct the inquiry on the allegation therein as well as the persons in the said complaint.

Reply has been filed on behalf of the respondent, which is taken on record and copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. As per para 9 of the said reply, the order has been complied with. The investigation of both the aforesaid cases FIR No.180 dated 21.06.2013 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC (added Sections 467, 468, 469, 471, 201 IPC), P.S. Civil Lines, Amritsar and FIR No.42 dated 07.02.2014 under Sections 420, 465, 466, 467, 471, 120-B IPC, PS Civil Lines, Amritsar has been carried out by the Special Investigation Team faily, on the basis of which, cancellation report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been prepared in FIR No. 42 dated 07.02.2014 under Sections 420, 465, 466, 467, 471, 120-B IPC PS Civil Lines, Amritsar and investigation of the case 180 dated 21.06.2013 under Section 420, 120-B IPC (added Sections 467, 468, 469, 471, 201 IPC), P.S.

Civil Lines, Amritsar has again been started, which will be taken to its logical conclusion.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to avail the remedy available to him in law in case he still aggrieved.
