Learned counsel for the petitioner/defendant No.1 at the very outset submits that though there may be some differences between petitioner (mother) and respondents No.1 and 2 (son and daughter-in-law respectively), said differences can be resolved by the trial Court itself by taking recourse to the mediation process.

Learned counsel for the petitioner/defendant No.1 submits that he does not want to proceed further with instant civil revision and the same be dismissed as withdrawn. Trial Court may explore to redress the grievances, if any, of parties to the suit by taking recourse to mediation process.

In view of above, instant civil revision impugning the legality of order dated 16.10.2019, is dismissed as withdrawn.
