The petitioner filed a writ petition seeking directions to the respondent to grant 3rd Assured Career Progression Scheme (ACP) after completion of 20 years of service and also to release the benefits of ACP on completion of 7,12 and 20 years of service.

The writ petition was disposed of on 27.7.2018 directing the respondent-Director, Urban Local Bodies Department, Haryana, to take decision on the representation.

The present petition is filed pleading that needful has not been done.

Reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Lalit Siwach, Director, Urban Local Bodies Department, Haryana, filed today in Court, is taken on record and copy supplied to counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that vide order dated 16.12.2019 the claim of the petitioner has been accepted and the monetary benefits arising from the said would be credited to the account of the petitioner within a week. He further undertakes that detail of the amount found due would be given to the petitioner within three weeks from today.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of.

However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to revive the contempt petition in case aggrieved of the calculation of the amount found due.
