[1] At the outset, learned counsel contends that the petitioner has served a legal notice (Annexure P-12) dated 18.05.2019 but the claim made in the same has not been decided till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage, by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice (Annexure P-12) dated 18.05.2019, in accordance with law, as well as the decision of a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court attached as Annexure P-13.

[2] In view of the innocuous nature of the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice (Annexure P-12) dated 18.05.2019 in accordance with law and by taking into account the decision of a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court (Annexure P-13) in case the same is applicable, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 02 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
