ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.182, dated 04.10.2018, under Sections 379-B and 411 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station Division No.4, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he along with other accused is alleged to have snatched a purse containing ₹1500/- and mobile phone from the complainant. He further contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and was arraigned as an accused 08 months after registration of the FIR. The petitioner is in custody for over 04 months and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel states that although challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 04 months and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
