The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 07.03.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 5469 of 2018. The operative part of the order is reproduced below:

“Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 – Director General, Horticulture, Haryana, Sector 21, Panchkula and No.3 – Deputy Commissioner, District Kaithal (Haryana) to consider the legal notice dated November 07, 2017 (P—5) and take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order as per rules, regulations and instructions issued by the Government from time to time as well as in the light of the judgment referred to above in para No.1 of this order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case of non compliance of this order, petitioner shall be at liberty to approach this Court.”

Reply filed by way of affidavit of Dr. Arjun Singh Saini, Director General, Horticulture, Haryana, is taken on record and a copy given to learned counsel for the petitioner. Along with reply, order dated 22.08.2019 has been

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner states that liberty be granted to avail remedies in accordance with law against order dated 22.08.2019.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with the liberty as prayed. Rule issued against respondents is discharged.
