ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 189, dated 24.07.2019, under Sections 458, 379-B, 353, 186, 332 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he along with other accused had assaulted the officials of Power Corporation and snatched ₹1500/- from them. The petitioner is in custody for about 03 months.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Bikramjit Singh states that the petitioner is also involved in several other cases and does not deserve the concession of regular bail. He also contends that the investigation of the case could not be completed as one of the co-accused had preferred an application and the matter is being inquired by the Police Officer.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for about 03 months and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
