Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.884 dated 27.12.2017 under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 379, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-10, Gurugram, District Gurugram.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 07.11.2019: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and three persons Mukesh, Sanjay @ Manda, Petu @ Hetram, named in the FIR, had given beatings to the complainant. It is further submitted that there is a delay of 05 days in registration of the FIR and similarly situated co-accused Naveen has been granted the concession of anticipatory bail vide

order dated 23.10.2019 passed in CRM-M-42328-2019...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harjeet Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 07.11.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
