AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (ORAL)

This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 30.05.2017 passed in CWP No. 12119 of 2017.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

“ In view of the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner, I dispose of the present writ petition with a direction to the Tehsildar Raikot-respondent No.3 to decide the mutation proceedings in pursuance to the order passed by the Commissioner as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage no cause of action survives for pressing the present contempt petition, as the mutation could not be finalized by the respondents as the matter was *sub-judice*. He further submits that now the matter has been decided by the civil court and he has moved an application for finalization the mutation proceedings.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.

There is no doubt that in case a request is made to the respondents and there is no impediment, mutation proceedings would be decided expeditiously.
