ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 585 dated 12.05.2018, under Section 174-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Jagadhri City, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is an accused in a complaint case under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. He had been granted bail by the trial Court in that case, but he could not appear before the Court for some time, as compromise had been effected and the petitioner was under the impression that the complaint would be withdrawn. He also contends that the petitioner was declared a 'proclaimed person' vide order dated 04.05.2018, but subsequently he appeared before the Court on 17.09.2019 and he is appearing regularly before the trial Court thereafter.

This Court, by the order dated 08.11.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Sushil Kumar states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 08.11.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
