Challenge is to the order dated 28.08.2019 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Phagwara, whereby evidence of plaintiff-petitioner has been closed by order.

A perusal of the impugned order shows that Ravi Bedi (PW-1) was examined on that day and no other witness was present in Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that total three witnesses have been examined and cross-examination of Ravinder Pal Ralli (PW-3) is required to be conducted, as he has been partly cross-examined. He prays that one opportunity be granted to conclude the evidence of plaintiff.

In the given circumstances of the case, in order to impart complete justice to the parties, this Court deems it appropriate to provide an opportunity to the plaintiff-petitioner to conclude his evidence.

In view of the said fact, impugned order dated 28.08.2019 (Annexure P-1) is set aside and the trial Court is directed to provide one

effective opportunity to plaintiff-petitioner to get the cross-examination of Ravinder Pal Ralli (PW-3) conducted and conclude his evidence, subject to costs of Rs.5,000/- to be deposited with the District Legal Services Authority, Phagwara/Kapurthala.

Allowed accordingly.
