The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 15.2.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 4204 of 2019, whereby respondent No. 3 (in the writ petition) was directed to decide the demand notice 10.7.2018.

There is nothing on record to establish that copy of the order was received by the respondent earlier to 30.9.2019. The directions of this Court were time-bound.

The contempt petition is disposed of.

There is no doubt that the respondent would realise seriousness of the matter that directions of this Court were time bound and the needful would be done within two months from the date of receipt of the order passed today. It is clarified that in case needful is not done, costs may be imposed which shall be recoverable personally from the defaulting official.
