Short affidavit has been filed by Ashwani Kumar Kansal, Chief Engineer/KAD, Water Resources Department (Irrigation Punjab), Chandigarh on behalf of respondents No. 1 and 2. the same is taken on record.

Perusal of the affidavit filed in Court today on behalf of respondents No. 1 and 2 would show that the retiral benefits have been paid to the petitioner. The relevant portion reads as under:-

“That in compliance with the order 16.10.2019 passed by this Hon'ble Court, payment of pension/arrears of pension amounting to Rs.10,54,488/- after deducting TDS as per income tax laws and gratuity amounting to Rs.4,35,765/- has been credited in the account of the petitioner on 24.10.2019. Further, the interest element amounting to Rs.6,80,719/- has also been credited in the account of the petitioner on 30.10.2019.”

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the

above, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
