The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.102 dated 08.09.2019, under Sections 306, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR do not *prima facie* constitute an offence punishable under Section 306 IPC. He also contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case on account of misunderstanding between the parties which has now been resolved.

This Court, by the order dated 07.11.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the investigating/arresting officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the investigating/arresting officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mandeep Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 07.11.2019 granting ad interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
