Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0122 dated 18.10.2019 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 452 IPC, registered at Police Station Surjanpur, District Pathankot.

While granting interim bail to the petitioners, following order was passed by this Court on 08.11.2019: -

“...Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the FIR has been registered on account of a sudden fight between the family members and even from the side of the complainant, two persons have suffered injuries. It is further submitted that the petitioners undertake to hand over a sum of Rs.15,000/- to the mother – Bimla Soni as a good gesture within a week...”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajesh Kumar, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioners are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 08.11.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
