The claim of the petitioner in the present writ petition is that though, the petitioner has been compulsorily retired on 16.10.2018 but, after the said retirement, the benefits for which the petitioner is entitled, have not been released by the respondents so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is no impediment in the release of the pensionary benefits as there are no proceedings pending against the petitioner either departmental or before any competent Court of law, which would entitle the respondents to withhold the pensionary benefits of the petitioner.

The prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to release the pensionary benefits in respect of the service rendered by him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 13.05.2019 (Annexure P-7) with the respondents, which is still pending consideration and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 13.05.2019 (Annexure P-7), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 13.05.2019 (Annexure P-7), within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits after the decision of the representation, the same should also be paid to him within three months thereafter.
