The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 114 dated 11.08.2019, under Sections 307, 323 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, besides Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the earlier petition preferred by the petitioner was dismissed as withdrawn on 23.10.2019. However, he has preferred this petition again, as the injury which is allegedly attributed to the petitioner has been found to be simple in nature. He also contends that the petitioner is alleged to have given a 'danda' blow on the head of injured - Harjit Singh. He also states that he wants to withdraw this petition, as the petitioner would surrender before the trial Court and prefer an application for bail and the trial Court may be directed to decide the same expeditiously.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn. In the event of the petitioner surrendering before the trial Court and preferring an application for regular bail, the same shall be decided in accordance with law expeditiously.
