Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the revision petition filed by him before the Divisional Commissioner Karnal, Panipat, bearing No. E.R. 612 of 2019 is not being decided in one way or the other whereas respondent No.5 is trying to take possession on the basis of the order passed by the Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Panipat. He has thus made an innocuous prayer of seeking a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the revision petition, in one way or the other, on the date already fixed i.e. 15.11.2019 or if it is not possible on the said date then within the time prescribed by this Court.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Kirti Singh, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2.

After perusing the record and taking into consideration the prayer made by the petitioner and after going through the available record, we are of the considered opinion that writ petition can be

disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 as prayed for.

Accordingly, the present revision is hereby allowed. Direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide revision petition No. E.R. 612 of 2019, ***Manga Versus Gram Panchayat*** filed by the petitioner on the date already fixed i.e. 15.11.2019 and if it is not possible then on the adjourned date.

Learned State counsel is directed to send the order of this Court today by way of e-mail to apprise the Divisional Commissioner Karnal, Camp at Panipat, for the purpose of its compliance.
