Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the instant revision petition with undertaking to vacate the demised house within 9 months from today.

Respondent-landlord, who is present along with his counsel in Court today, has no objection in dismissing this revision petition as withdrawn and granting 9 months time to the petitioner for vacation of the demised house. Thus the petitioner, in view of his undertaking, is directed to vacate the demised house within 9 months from today i.e. latest by 5th June, 2020 and hand over vacant possession to the respondent. In case, the petitioner does not vacate the demised house within the stipulated period he shall be liable to pay mesne profit @ Rs.35,000/- per month.

Petitioner is directed to submit his undertaking to the abovestated effect before the Executing Court within a week positively.
