It is alleged that the complainant lodged an FIR against one Manpreet Singh @ Bablu, aged about 28-29 years. On account of lodging of FIR and on account of fear of arrest, Manpreet Singh @ Bablu committed suicide. On account of the which FIR under Section 306 IPC was registered against the petitioner. It will be a debatable point that if only on account of lodging of FIR, Manpreet Singh @ Bablu committed suicide and whether the offence under Section 306 IPC will be attracted? It is not deemed proper to comment on the merits of the case at this stage.

Interim bail granted to the petitioner on 15.12.2018 is made absolute.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
