Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.09 dated 11.07.2018, registered at Police Station Verka, Police Commissionerate Amritsar, under Sections 323, 324 and 34 IPC and Section 307 IPC (added later on).

It has been pointed out that in the present case, compromise (Annexure P-2) has been effected between the parties.

On 18.11.2019, this Court passed the following order :-

“On 7.11.2019, notice of motion was issued by this Court while taking into consideration the fact that a petition i.e. CRM-M-25778-2019 for quashing of the FIR in question, on the basis of compromise between the parties, has been filed by the petitioner.

It has been pointed out by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the statement of the parties before the trial

Court is to be recorded on 19.11.2019.

The factum of compromise between the parties has not been disputed by counsel for respondent No. 2.

Keeping in view the above facts, petitioner is directed to join the investigation and if he is sought to be arrested, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer subject to the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Adjourned to 29.11.2019.

Copy of the order be given dasti under the signatures of Reader of this Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 18.11.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagjit Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 18.11.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
