[1] Prayer is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for granting the petitioners' benefit of 1st & 2nd ACP as per ACP Rules, 1998 and Instructions (Annexures P-1 & P-2) with effect from the date of entitlement on completion of 10 and 20 years of service respectively.

[2] Learned counsel contends that the petitioners have submitted representations (Annexures P-5 & P-6) dated 27.07.2018 and 11.09.2019 but the same have not been decided till date and in the circumstances, the petitioners would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representations (Annexures P-5 & P-6) dated 27.07.2018 and 11.09.2019 in the light of decision of this Court in CWP No.23074 of 2010 dated 24.07.2015, in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

[3] Notice of motion.

[4] Mr. Harish Rathee, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no object to the aforementioned limited prayer of the petitioners.

[5] Without commenting on the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioners to the relief claimed, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representations (Annexures P-5 & P-6) dated 27.07.2018 and 11.09.2019, in accordance with rules and instructions applicable as well as decision of this Court in CWP No.23074 of 2010 dated 24.07.2015 in case the same is applicable within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
