“(a) The respondent-Police Authorities be restrained from threatening and harassing the petitioner so as to force him to illegally comply with the compromise, Annexure P-3 dated 29.9.2018, which is illegal and otherwise not enforceable in law.

(b) Respondent Nos. 2 and 3 be directed to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner;

(c) Any other order or direction which this Hon'le Court deems fit under the facts and circumstances of the present case may kindly be issued.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Bhupinder Singh has submitted that initially the parties had entered into a settlement and thereafter subsequent complaint filed by the petitioner has been found to

be without any substance and therefore filed.

In view thereof, present petition is disposed of by relegating the petitioner to alternate remedies in law.
