ARUN MONGA, J.(ORAL)

1. Petitioner herein seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to regularize him as Sweeper Grade-IV as he has been working on DC rates as daily wager since 01.04.1995.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that similarly situated employees, who are even juniors to the petitioner have been regularized by the respondents vide order dated 12.07.2014 (Annexure P-2).

3. In the premise, petitioner submitted a representation dated 28.07.2014 (Annexure P-3), but the same has not been adverted to by the respondents till date. Hence, the writ petition.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On advance service of the petition, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional A.G., Punjab appears and accepts notice on

behalf of the State.

6. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

7. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representation dated 28.07.2014 (Annexure P-3) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

8. Let the needful be done within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

9. Disposed of in above terms.
