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KULDIP SINGH, J.

This revision has been filed against order dated 8.8.2017, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bhiwani, affirming the order dated 10.7.2017, passed by learned Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Bhiwani, whereby bail application filed by present petitioner in conflict with law was dismissed.

Petitioner has been booked in FIR No. 175, dated 20.9.2015, under Sections 392, 395, 120-B IPC read with Section 34 IPC and under Section 25 of Arms Act, Police Station Behal, District Bhiwani, Haryana.

We have heard learned counsel for parties and have perused the orders of both the Courts below. The perusal of orders shows that in addition to present case, present petitioner has also been booked in FIR No. 22, dated 30.1.2016, under Sections 302, 120-B IPC and under Arms Act, registered at Police Station Bichhuva, Rajasthan. The said crime was committed after commission of present crime. Petitioner has also been

booked in another case in FIR No. 86 of 2015, under Sections 394, 397 IPC and under Section 25 of Arms Act. Petitioner is already in custody in murder case. The Courts below have taken the view that if petitioner is released on bail, there is clear possibility that he may come into association with known criminals. Otherwise also, petitioner is in custody in another FIR registered under Section 302 IPC and if he is released in present case, it will be useless exercise. It being so, there is no illegality or infirmity in orders passed by both the Courts below. Hence, revision is dismissed.
