Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner will be satisfied in case, he is granted the benefit of service rendered by him as an SPO as a qualifying service for computing the pensionary benefits and also by treating him under the old pension scheme keeping in view the settled principle of law settled by the Full Bench of this Court in **Kesar Chand Vs. State of Punjab, 1988 (5) SLR 27** and in **CWP No. 2371 of 2010 titled as Harbans Lal Vs. State of Punjab and others, decided on 31.08.2010.**

On being asked as to whether the petitioner had raised this grievance before the respondents at any given point of time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the respondents raising his claim for granting him the benefit as noticed above.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as prayed for.
