The prayer of the petitioner in this case is to direct regularization of his services as a Computer Operator in Sonapat Central Co-operative Bank Limited, Sonapat, as he has been working as such since 23.10.2007 on contract basis. He seeks this relief in view of the judgment dated 04.10.2018 passed in CWP No.2009 of 2016, titled 'Balwinder Singh and others V/s. State of Haryana and others'

Mr. Subhash Ahuja, learned counsel for the respondent-bank, would inform this Court that the petitioner already filed a writ petition seeking the very same relief, viz, CWP No.26127 of 2017, and that the

same is still pending on the file of this Court.

Perusal of the prayer in the said writ petition reflects that the petitioner sought the very same relief of regularization of his services therein. As regards the decision cited by the petitioner, it may be noted that the said decision was set aside in appeal and the cases were remanded for fresh hearing.

Be it viewed from any angle, this Court finds no ground to entertain this second writ petition when the petitioner's first case, seeking the same relief, is still pending

The writ petition is dismissed on this short ground.
